The Firestone brand recently celebrated its 114th birthday on August 3, and at 111 years old, the Milwaukee Mile is the oldest operating motor speedway in the world. The Mile has hosted at least one auto race every year since 1903 (except during World War II).

Indianapolis 500 winner Ryan Hunter-Reay lays down a hot lap at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course two weekends ago. The American driver returns to Milwaukee seeking his third straight win on the one-mile oval. Can Hunter-Reay, who used a three-race win streak beginning at Milwaukee to propel him into championship contention in 2012, make another push for the title with his fourth win of the 2014 season?

WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

CHAMPIONSHIP RACE HEADS TO MILWAUKEE: Will Power took back the lead in the Verizon IndyCar Series standings from teammate Helio Castroneves at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course on Aug. 3 and carries a four-point advantage over the Brazilian into the ABC Supply Wisconsin 250 at Milwaukee IndyFest. Can Power take advantage of Team Penske's knowledge of Milwaukee (seven wins) and maintain his points lead?



BOURDAIS AIMS FOR ANOTHER VICTORY: Sebastien Bourdais returns to the Milwaukee Mile with KVSH Racing with the form that helped him win four straight Champ Car titles from 2004-2007. Bourdais, who won at Milwaukee from pole in 2006, made his first start at the Mile since his title-winning days in 2013. Can the Frenchman regain his winning form at Milwaukee?

KANAAN HOPES TO CONTINUE MILE MASTERY: With six top-five finishes in his last nine starts at Milwaukee, Tony Kanaan has definitely earned the title of Milwaukee Master. Kanaan won at Milwaukee in 2006 and 2007 and finished second in 2012. The ABC Supply Wisconsin 250 will mark Kanaan's 231st consecutive Indy car start, which will extend his all-time record. Can Kanaan add a third Milwaukee trophy this weekend?
