WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

MONTOYA AIMS FOR FIRST TORONTO WIN: Juan Pablo Montoya (right) has controlled the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings since the start of the season and carries a 35-point advantage into the Honda Indy Toronto over teammate Will Power. But the Colombian hasn't fared well in Toronto, never finishing in the top 15 in four previous starts. Can Montoya score his first win in Toronto this weekend?



RESURGENT GANASSI TEAM SEEKS ANOTHER WIN AT TORONTO: Chip Ganassi Racing hopes to recapture its success on the streets of Toronto, where it has won six times previously.
