WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

THREE WINNERS IN FOUR RACES: There have been three different winners in the four races thus far in 2016: Juan Pablo Montoya (Streets of St. Petersburg), Scott Dixon (Phoenix International Raceway) and Simon Pagenaud (Streets of Long Beach & Barber Motorsports Park). Will this weekend see the fourth winner of the season?

PENSKÉ ON POLE IN 2016: Drivers from Team Penske are the only drivers to earn the Verizon P1 Award in 2016. Will Power (St. Petersburg), Helio Castroneves (Phoenix and Long Beach) and Simon Pagenaud (Barber) earned Verizon P1 Awards through qualifying. Pagenaud even started on pole at St. Petersburg after Power became ill at St. Pete. Can Penske continue its dominance in qualifying?

FIVE STRIVE FOR IMS DOUBLE: Five drivers have a chance to become the first driver to win on both the Indianapolis Motor Speedway's road course and the famed 2.5-mile oval: Ryan Hunter-Reay, Tony Kanaan, Scott Dixon, Helio Castroneves and Juan Pablo Montoya have all won the Indianapolis 500.

Primary display, showing the car's position in the running order. Blinks when the position has changed from previous lap.

PUSH-TO-PASS: FLASHES GREEN

Display flashes "PP" in green while the car's push-to-pass is active.

Example: Car with active P2P.



PIT STOP TIMER: GREEN

Display shows a running clock during a pit stop in seconds.

Example: 7.9-second pit stop.
