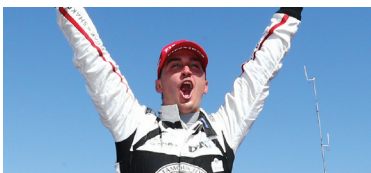


RED-HOT POWER SEEKS ANOTHER BOOST TO TITLE HOPES: With three wins in the last four races, including the July 17 Honda Indy Toronto, Will Power (left) has raced his way into Verizon IndyCar Series title contention. The Australian lies 47 points behind his teammate Simon Pagenaud, despite missing the season-opening race at St. Petersburg. Can Power continue to eat into Pagenaud's point lead at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course?

WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

RAHAL RETURNS TO MID-OHIO TO DEFEND TITLE: While wearing racing gear inspired by The Ohio State University, the New Albany, Ohio native Graham Rahal added his own chapter to his family's storied history at Mid-Ohio by winning at the track 30 years after his father Bobby Rahal last won there.



GANASSI TEAM SEEKS ANOTHER MID-OHIO WIN: Chip Ganassi Racing hopes to keep its successful run going at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course, where it has won 10 times, including six of the last seven races. Scott Dixon has won four races at Mid-Ohio, including the 2014 race after starting last, while Charlie Kimball claimed his first win there in 2013. Can Ganassi win for the seventh time in eight years?

FAST FRENCHMEN IN OHIO: Simon Pagenaud has finished on the podium three times in his previous five starts. Sebastien Bourdais has three top-five finishes in six starts.

PUSH-TO-PASS: FLASHES GREEN

PIT STOP TIMER: GREEN

Display shows a running clock during a pit stop in seconds.

Example: 7.9-second pit stop.
