## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

**NEW ERA, NEW CAR:** While level of experience varies among drivers, everyone is on the same footing when it comes to the new 2012 IZOD IndyCar Series car. The new car adds an element of competition that has not been seen since the last time a new car was introduced in 2003. The new car plan began in 2010, overseen by a hand-picked committee of mechanical experts and technical gurus who have guided the process to its fulfillment. Drivers have spent almost the entire offseason in team tests shaking down the car as they prepare for the season, and INDYCAR held its first official test on March 5-6 and 8-9.



**ENGINE MANUFACTURER COMPETITION RETURNS:** For the first time since 2005, the IZOD IndyCar Series will have different manufacturers producing the engines that power the cars. Honda, Chevrolet and Lotus engines will be utilized in 2012. Where competition used to mainly exist among the teams, the opposing engines will add a new level of competition to the series. Teams powered by Honda engines include Target Chip Ganassi Racing, Service Central Chip Ganassi Racing, Novo Nordisk Chip Ganassi Racing, Sarah Fisher Hartman Racing, Dale Coyne Racing, Schmidt-Hamilton Motorsports, A.J. Foyt Enterprises and Rahal Letterman Lanigan Racing. Chevrolet will power Team Penske, Andretti Autosport, Panther Racing, KV Racing Technology and Ed Carpenter Racing. Lotus-Dragon Racing, Lotus-HVM Racing, Lotus-DRR and Bryan Herta Autosport will have Lotus engines.
