WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

POWER LOOKS TO REPEAT AT TEXAS:

With wins at Barber, Long Beach and São Paulo, Will Power (right) finds himself atop the IZOD IndyCar Series point standings. Power, who claimed his first oval win at Texas last year, saw championship rival Scott Dixon gain ground with a win at Belle Isle. Can Power pad his lead with another win in Texas or can Dixon cut into Power's advantage?



PANTHER & HILDEBRAND EYE VICTORY LANE: Panther Racing has won five races at Texas Motor Speedway, second only to Team Penske for most IZOD IndyCar Series wins at Texas. Tomas Scheckter (2005), Sam Hornish Jr. (2001-02) and Scott Goodyear (1999-2000) all drove a Panther car to Victory Lane at Texas. Can JR Hildebrand help Panther Racing claim its sixth victory at the Great American Speedway?

CLOSE RACING A HALLMARK AT TEXAS: In the 23 previous races at Texas, 16 have finished with a margin of victory of less than one second, and eight races have been decided by less than one-tenth of a second. Will the Firestone 550 live up to the history and produce another photo finish at Texas?
