WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

POWER LOOKS TO TIGHTEN GRASP ON LEAD: With wins at St. Petersburg and Belle Isle, Will Power finds himself atop the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings. The Australian claimed a win in the second Houston race in 2013 and is the only driver to finish in the top 10 in every race so far. Can Power pad his lead with another win in Houston and strengthen his hold on the series championship lead?



DOUBLING DOWN IN H-TOWN: The Shell and Pennzoil Grand Prix of Houston will mark the second of three doubleheaders on the 2014 Verizon IndyCar Series schedule. Drivers will contest a pair of 90-lap races Saturday and Sunday on the 1.69-mile temporary street circuit at NRG Park. Can a driver sweep the races and be crowned king of the streets in Houston?

BOURDAIS AIMS TO RETURN TO VICTORY LANE AT HOUSTON: Sebastien Bourdais returns to MD Anderson Cancer Center Speedway with KVSH Racing in search of his third win on the NRG Park street circuit. The four-time Champ Car champion has finished in the top 10 in each of his starts at Houston, including a fifth-place finish last season. Can the Frenchman continue his championship form at Houston?

FOYT AND SATO A WINNING COMBO: A.J. Foyt likes the speed and aggressiveness he sees in Takuma Sato and the Japanese driver has already brought the four-time Indianapolis 500 winner a pair of pole positions in 2014. Now Sato aims to deliver Foyt a win in his hometown of Houston. Can honorary Texan Sato take the racing legend's team — run by Houston native Larry Foyt — to victory lane in their home state?
