WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

ANDRETTI AT HOME IN IOWA: Marco Andretti may hail from Nazareth, Pennsylvania, but he is very much at home on the 7/8-mile oval at Iowa Speedway. The third-generation driver is aiming for his first win of the 2014 season, but Andretti has four podium finishes in seven Iowa Speedway starts. Andretti last won a Verizon IndyCar Series race at Iowa in 2011 — can he add another win to his Iowa résumé this year?



TIED AT THE TOP: Helio Castroneves took advantage of a double points weekend at Pocono and tied Will Power at the top of the Verizon IndyCar Series points standings with a second-place finish. Power leads Castroneves by virtue of the wins tiebreaker, but Simon Pagenaud (44 points back), Juan Pablo Montoya (55 points) and Ryan Hunter-Reay (58 points back) are not too far behind.

WILL COMPETITIVE SEASON SEE NINTH WINNER IN 12 RACES?: The 2014 Verizon IndyCar Series season has seen eight winners in the first 11 races, including wins by Ed Carpenter Racing, Schmidt Peterson Motorsports and Dale Coyne Racing — which featured first-time winner Carlos Huertas. Will the trend of small team success continue at Iowa or will it be one of the series' heavyweights that comes away with the coveted gas pump trophy?
