WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

TWO NEW WINNERS AT BELLE ISLE: Andretti Autosport's Carlos Muñoz (right) picked up a win in Saturday's rain-shortened Race 1 in Detroit, while four-time champ Sebastien Bourdais claimed victory for KVSH Racing in Race 2 of the doubleheader on Sunday. It was the first win for both drivers in 2015, a season that has seen seven winners in eight races — only Indianapolis 500 winner Juan Pablo Montoya has a second win under his belt, the season opener at St. Pete. Will we see another new winner on the oval at Texas?



CARPENTER LOOKS TO BUILD ON 2014 WIN: Ed Carpenter scored a popular win at TMS in 2014 and enters the Firestone 600 looking to rebound from a disappointing month of May at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Can Carpenter regain his oval mojo and win again in the Lone Star State?

POWER LOOKS TO WIN AT "HOME" TRACK: With a win at the Grand Prix of Indianapolis, Will Power finds himself a strong contender to repeat as Verizon IndyCar Series champion. Though he is from Toowoomba, Australia, Power, who claimed his first oval win at Texas in 2011, considers Texas a home race because his wife Elizabeth is from nearby Plano. Can Power claim another win at his "home track"?
