PAGENAUD LOOKS TO TIGHTEN GRASP ON CHAMPIONSHIP LEAD:

With his fourth win of the season at Mid-Ohio, Simon Pagenaud remains atop the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings. The Frenchman leads Will Power by 58 points but with 500 miles ahead at Pocono, anyone could make a move. Can Pagenaud claim his first 500-mile win at Pocono and strengthen his hold on the series championship lead?

WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

ANOTHER FIRST-TIME WINNER AT TRICKY TRIANGLE?: A different driver has won the three previous races at Pocono with Scott Dixon, Juan Pablo Montoya and Ryan Hunter-Reay visiting victory lane since the series returned in 2013. Will one of those drivers conquer the Tricky Triangle again? Or can another new winner be crowned?

ROSSI AIMS FOR 500-MILE SWEEP: After winning his first 500-mile race in the 100th Running of the Indianapolis 500 in May, Alexander Rossi looks to add another 500-mile win to his resume. The rookie used a combination of speed and strategy to win his first Verizon IndyCar Series race. Can he conquer another test of man and machine this week?

ANDRETTI LOOKS FOR BREAKTHROUGH WIN AT HOMETOWN TRACK: Marco Andretti will compete in a virtual hometown race at Pocono. Andretti can lean on family ties for some advice as Pocono is one of two tracks where all three generations of racing's most famous family have had success. Andretti's grandfather, racing legend Mario Andretti, won the 1986 Pocono race, the same year that Marco's father, Michael, won the pole. Marco claimed the pole for the Pocono race in 2013.
