

CAN WILSON DO IT AGAIN?: Justin Wilson scored his first win on an oval at Texas, but he's never finished in in the top five on the Milwaukee Mile oval. Can Wilson, who leads the A.J. Foyt Oval Trophy points by the tiebreaker over Ryan Briscoe, maintain his lead and take control of the championship within the IZOD IndyCar Series championship?



SERIES HEADS BACK TO MILWAUKEE: Open-wheel racing returns to the Milwaukee Mile with the IZOD IndyCar Series headlining the Milwaukee IndyFest race weekend. The IZOD IndyCar Series raced at the famed one-mile oval from 2004-2009 and returned to the track last season, but the track has played host to Indy car racing since 1912. Dario Franchitti won the return race in 2011. Who will write their name in the history books this year?
