WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

WELCOME TO HINCHTOWN: James Hinchcliffe attended the Honda Indy Toronto for the first time as an 18-month-old toddler. This year, the Toronto native will race in his hometown with a chance to win the race. Can Hinch, who scored a podium at Toronto in Firestone Indy Lights in 2009, visit Victory Lane in his hometown race?



POINTS RACE TIGHTENS: After dominating the first quarter of 2012, Will Power has seen his points lead shrink since the Indianapolis 500, but the Team Penske standout hopes to rebound on the streets of Toronto's Exhibition Place. The Australian leads Ryan Hunter-Reay by three points with Scott Dixon 15 behind. The driver leading the series championship at the midway point of the season has won the title in six of the last 13 seasons, dating to the 1996-97 season.

BOURDAIS BACK AT TORONTO: Former race winner Sebastien Bourdais returns to the IZOD IndyCar Series with Dale Coyne Racing. The four-time Champ Car champion scored a win on the streets of Exhibition Place in 2005 and pole position in 2004. Can the Frenchman regain his championship form at Toronto?
