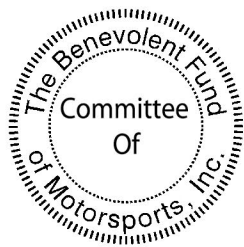

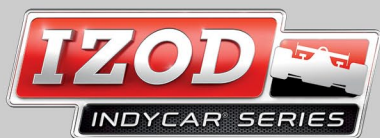

WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

HELIO CLOSES ON HUNTER-REAY:

Coming off a win at Edmonton, Helio Castroneves (right) will look to add the winner's trophy from Mid-Ohio to his trophy case. Castroneves trails Ryan Hunter-Reay in the IZOD IndyCar Series point standings by 23 markers with Will Power just three points behind. Can Castroneves, a two-time winner at Mid-Ohio, continue to close the gap on Hunter-Reay?



POWER SEEKS BOOST AT MID-OHIO: Will Power will look to add victory at Mid-Ohio to his growing collection of road/street course wins. The Aussie, who at Edmonton scored his first podium finish since a win at São Paulo, won the pole at Mid-Ohio in 2010. Can Power, who dominated the first quarter of 2012, rebound from his recent string of bad luck to win at Mid-Ohio?
